You may be out of your comfort zones on the trip. There may be growing pains on the trip. You may not always have it your way on the trip, but for everyone to have a successful trip you must be friendly flexible & full of grace —— AND you must keep to these expectations. They are REQUIRED.

FRIENDLY

Willingness to work with your teammates in a friendly manner, throughout the duration of the trip.

FLEXIBLE

Willingness to adjust to the changes or requirements on the trip. Whether convenient or not.

FULL OF GRACE

Always responding to people & situations with kindness and patience. No SNARKY remarks or COMPLAINING.

EXPECTATIONS BEFORE THE TRIP

You have to update your trip leader on your support raising progress each week.

You MUST attend mission meeting & mission training.

if you can't make one, plz communicate with team leader immediately!

EXPECTATIONS WHILE ON THE TRIP

YOU **MUST** LISTEN TO YOUR TEAM LEADER!

You **cannot wander** from the group without a **CLEAR** approval from the team leader!

More information & expectations will be communicated to the group on the trip!

The expectations for the trip is set to ensure the safety & a positive experience for each person.

If concluded by the team leaders that a certain individual is unable to consistently comply by these expectations, such an one may be relieved from the trip prematurely.

- Writing out an *appeal* for the mission trip to ask potential donors (we help you with this).
- Creating a *list of people* you know as potential donors (use Facebook friend list).
- Begin making contact with individuals for support
- DO NOT PROCRASTINATE.....
- Mission Trip leaders & staff leaders will check up on you and guide you as you raise funds.

BIBLICAL BASIS

Asking people for money??? What?? Don't worry!
Support raising is a tool God has used since Moses!
God knows when we are doing work in His Kingdom, there will come a point where financial needs will have to be met.

Whether you want to be a missionary long term or just go on a short term mission trip, raising support for these will not just benefit you, but it will benefit the giver as well! Here are a few scriptures that give Biblical basis for support raising and for encouragement!

1 KINGS 17:7-16 2 CORINTHIANS 8:1-9:15 PHILIPPIANS 4:10 - 20

WHERE TO BEGIN??

HOMEWORK!

Write out **30 to 100 people** that you are associated with (**NOT STUDENTS AT PV**). This could be mother, father, co-worker, friend from high school, professors, church home, etc. If you know someone who is gifted at support raising, ask them for references! Not everyone you ask will give and that is okay! But there are those who are willing to give!



FOLLOW UP!!

If the person you contacted does not respond, leave a voicemail, and wait 2 days before contacting them again.

If you've left 2 voicemails and you hear no response, move onto the next person. Continue looking at your list and/or get references from someone who is trained in support raising for help.



WHAT TO SAY

PHONE CALL APPEAL:

"Hi! How're you doing? I'm calling because I have an opportunity to go on a mission trip this spring break. I'm with Chi Alpha, a campus ministry and we're partnering with another Chi Alpha ministry at an HBCU, University of Arkansas Pine Bluff to reach out to their campus. My budget for this trip is \$350. That means roughly 4 people who donate \$100 or more. Would you be willing or able to give to support me to go on this trip?

VOICEMAIL SCRIPT:

"Hello____, I hope you're doing well, I was calling because I have this opportunity to go on a mission trip to serve on another campus Pine Bluff Arkansas this spring break. I will call you again in 2 days if I do not hear back from you! Thank you! God bless!

Frequently asked questions!

WHY SHOULD I GO ON THIS TRIP?

You have an opportunity to change people's lives. It will positively change your life and eternity.

WHAT ARE WE GOING TO DO THERE?

Team will work with Pine Bluff XA ministries to outreach to the campus. We will assist the work to reach the students they've been ministering to.

WHERE WILL WE STAY?

We will be staying with the missionaries at PB and potentially Air BnB.

WHY IS THE BUDGET SO HIGH? WHAT DOES THE BUDGET COVER?

Budget was set based on the outreach needs. It covers accommodation, feeding, travel and everything else needed for the trip.

HOW DO I GET THE MONEY?

The money will be fund raised. The team leaders & staff will guide you on the fundraising process.

SHOULD I RAISE THE MONEY? WHY CAN'T I JUST PAY FOR IT MYSELF?

No one should have to pay for the trip. The trip is a cause, and you are invited to share the cause with your friends and family and ask if they'd be willing to support you in this cause.

WHAT IF I CAN'T RAISE THE BUDGET?

You will be able to raise the money. No one has not gone on a mission trip because of an inability to raise the funds. No one!

HOW DO I KNOW WHEN SOMEONE HAS GIVEN MONEY FOR MY TRIP?

We will walk you through the raising process. Managed missions will show you the progress.



Frequently asked questions! pt. 2.

WHAT IF I CHANGE MY MIND AFTER RAISING SOME OF THE MONEY? IF I DON'T GO ON THE TRIP DOES THE MONEY I RAISE GET REFUNDED?

No. Whatever is raised goes to to collective budget for the trip. That budget is used to acquire needs for the trips. Those funds cannot be returned. Donors will receive a tax deductible receipt.

MY PARENTS AREN'T COMFORTABLE WITH THE TRIP, WHAT SHOULD I DO?

The Chi Alpha Staff are glad to communicate with your parents about the trip if need be. Also, these documents are meant to give you & them an idea of what the trip is about.

WHO SHOULD MY PARENTS TALK TO ABOUT THE TRIP? The XA staff

MY PARENTS THINK I'M BEGGING FOR MONEY, WHAT SHOULD I DO? I WAS TAUGHT NEVER TO ASK FOR MONEY......

Many non-profit organizations raise money for their independent causes. This is no different. This is a cause you're raising money for. You're appealing for the spreading of the gospel. The gospel is worth raising money for. You're not begging.

WHAT HAPPENS TO ALL THAT MONEY? DO I GET TO KEEP SOME?

Everything raised goes to the collective needs of the trip. Neither you nor anyone gets to keep the money. See team leaders for budget breakdown.

CAN I MISS A MISSION TRIP MEETING?

No, unless absolutely necessary. See team leader for information.
